Fiona Payne teaches drawing workshops to people of all ages throughout the local area. her workshops have been delivered to schools, College students as well as many adults at seminars, classes and demonstrations.

The Workshops

A comprehensive art course made up of 5 workshops per half term spanning 3 terms, aiming to prepare children from the age of 8 upwards for art in their future whether it be for GCSE/A Level or just for enjoyment, relaxation and fun! Learning terminology, skills and new techniques including brief art history and plenty of fun!!!

Cost is £10 per session so £50 per half term. All materials are included as well as a drink, biscuit and an apron!

TERM 1

1st half term dates = September 12th September 19th, September 26th, October 3th, October 10th

FRUIT & VEG; - a 5-week course dedicated to exploring fruit and vegetables through a variety of mediums. Observational drawing is the number one skill and we will be working with an interesting mix of charcoal, pastels- both oil and chalk, pen and wash, biro, watercolour, pencil shading and coffee!!!!

Looking at a variety of relevant artists along the way.

2nd half term dates = November 7th, November 14th, November 21st, November 28th, December 5th

SKULLS & PUMPKINS; - Concentrating on drawing and developing a more finished approach to a piece of work. Investigating papers and finishes and adding unusual washes. Referencing artists and colour theory.

TERM 2

1st half term dates = January 16th, January 23th January 30th, February 6th February 13th

BODY BITS! - Focus will be on looking at hands and feet as well as eyes and mouth. Taking part in some quick, timed exercises and ending up lengthy detailed drawings working with different papers and products.

2nd half term dates = February 27th, March 5th, March 12th, March 19th, March 26th

RUSTY HINGES: - Working from photographs, starting with a drawing lesson. Following on by working in Acrylic paint onto a canvas with brushes and palette knives.

TERM 3

1st half term dates = April 23rd, April 30th, May 7th, May 14th, May 21st

BIRDS: - Studying large birds through drawing, water colour and ink and detailed pieces on Owls in coloured pencils. Looking at different artists.

2nd half term dates = June 4th, June 11th, June 18th, June 25th, July 2nd

COLLAGE: - Working on a large scale finished piece, using some collage and printing to achieve a finished collage relating to beach finds. Using artists to inspire large scale loose style pieces with lots of different mediums
